## Beer Battered Striped Bass

### Ingredients:

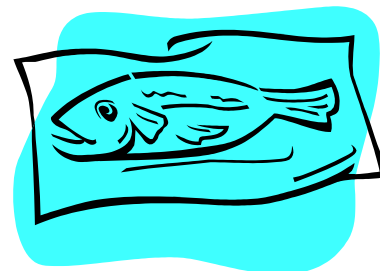
- 2 Pounds Bass Fillets
- Lemon Juice
- 1/2 Cup Peanut Oil
- 1 Cup flour
- 1/2 teaspoon salt
- 1/4 teaspoon cayenne pep-  
per
- 1 cup beer

### Preparation:

- Slice filets into 2-inch  
strips.
- Sprinkle with lemon juice

and roll in flour seasoned  
with salt and pepper.  
• For batter combine flour,  
salt and cayenne pepper,  
then gradually blend in beer  
until thoroughly mixed.  
• Heat oil in fish fryer to  
375°.  
• Dip filets in batter and fry  
until golden brown (2 min-  
utes on average).  
• Drain on paper towel to re-  
move excess grease.

- Serve with hot sauce or  
tarter sauce.
